During Lent, people often give up something they really like as a way to remember Jesus not being tempted for forty days when in the desert.


Jesus gave his life for us, but rather than give something up, what can we give to Jesus as way to remember what He did for us?

How can we walk with Jesus this Lent?





- Anyone over the age of 21 can apply to foster
- Q. Am i too old to foster? A. There is no upper age Limit to foster
- Q. Do I need experience with children to foster?
- A. No! Not everyone has experience with children. We provide all the training and support that you will need to foster.
- Can I foster if I am gay?

- Q. Can i foster if i work?

- A. Yes! Working carers can provide a structured family Life for children.
- Q. I'm on benefits can i foster?
- A. Yes! Anyone can apply to foster, whether you are Living on benefirs, working part Time, working full Time or are retired.
- Q. Do i need a spare room?
- A. Yes. ALL chiLdren requiring foster placements require their own bedroom. However, foster carers can care for a baby in their bedroom up until the child reaches 24 months.


